

Great Northern Corridor

The Great Northern includes 3,422 route miles traversing eight states and reaching three Canadian Provinces

Almost 25 million people live and work in the areas served by the Great Northern

Areas served by the Great Northern account for over \$1.4 trillion in gross domestic product and almost 12 million jobs



The Great Northern Corridor serves ports in Washington, Oregon and British Columbia, offering export service for agriculture, raw materials and finished goods. From western ports, the Great Northern ultimately connects to vital logistics parks and eastern rail connections in Chicago and beyond.

In 2009, the Great Northern moved over 124 million tons of freight. It would take over 4.9 million long-haul trucks on highways to move that much freight. The Great Northern saved over 570 million gallons of fuel and over 6 million tons of greenhouse gases.

BNSF has made substantial investments in the Great Northern Corridor to meet freight demands.

- BNSF has invested over \$143 million expanding capacity on the Great Northern over the last 10 years - mainly on sidings, which are like passing lanes for railroads that enable freight to move faster
- Over \$250 million in improvements have been made to the Stampede Pass between Auburn and Ellensburg, Washington to increase capacity to the west coast
- More than \$1.4 billion was spent on the Great Northern in the last 10 years to maintain its infrastructure to ensure the safe movement of goods

More needs to be done to expand and improve the Great Northern Corridor. Investments on this Corridor create a more efficient freight railway system to foster economic growth. These efficiency improvements mean fewer trucks on the road, lower emissions and a healthier, safer environment.
